Board of Trustees | The Board met in December for our regular quarterly session. I attended all of my committees, and open session. In the Open, I delivered a speech to fellow Trustees and the Senior Leadership team, sharing gratitude to students, staff, and faculty across campus for various initiatives. I also expressed how Queen's need to continue developing as a place where students feel supported, seen, and able to do their best work. This includes the need for more physical spaces, especially as our student population slowly grows. Open session also passed several motions, including the re-appointment of our auditors at KPMG LLP and amendments to the Board of Trustees By-Laws for housekeeping purposes but also to enhance clarity.
