2. Engineering and Applied Science Students are assessed on a per unit basis up to 16.1 units per term. The maximum per term tuition is equal to 1/2 of the tuition fee.
3. The Student Assistance Levy (SAL) is applied on a per term basis using the following charts. There is no ceiling on SAL.

Supplemental examinations incur a fee of \$300.00 per exam (see Faculty calendar for details).

6. Registration in PACT 338 or 438 incurs an additional fee of \$400.00 per course.
