These awards are made annually to women graduates of Queen's University for a year of study and research or to pursue an endeavour, which contributes to the advancement of knowledge, contributes to society or allows creative expression.

The **Marty Memorial Scholarship** was established in 1936 by the Queen's Alumni Association in memory of Dr. Aletta Marty, M.A. 1894, LL.D. 1919, and her sister, Sophie Marty, a distinguished graduate of Queen's University. Dr. Marty was a pioneer woman in the field of education, and Canada's first woman public school inspector. Miss Sophie Marty was for many years Head of the Department of Modern Language at Stratford Collegiate Institute.

The **Jean Royce Fellowship** was established in memory of Jean I. Royce, B.A.'30, LL.D.'68, Registrar, Queen's University, and was awarded for the first time in 1987.

The **Alfred Bader Fellowship in Memory of Jean Royce** was established in November 2003 by Alfred Bader, Sc '45, Arts '46, M.Sc. '47, LL.D. '86, and other friends, in memory of Jean I. Royce, B.A. 1930, LL.D. 1968, Registrar, Queen's University, and awarded to a woman graduate of Queen's University for one year of study and research or to pursue an endeavour which contributes to the advancement of knowledge, contributes to society, or allows creative expression.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. These awards are given to women graduates of Queen's University for a year of study and/or research. Payments will be disbursed as a scholarship.
2. Recipients of these scholarships may concurrently hold other scholarships and awards so long as the total value of funding available for the application year does not exceed \$55,000 (Canadian Dollars). If necessary, the value of these awards will be adjusted to bring the total funding available for the year to \$55,000. Recipients will, at the time of notification, be requested to declare all scholarship/fellowships available for the year.
3. Eligibility is restricted to those women who will have completed all of the requirements for a Queen's degree by the spring convocation in the year of the competition.
4. Under special circumstances an award may be given to the same person for a second year in competition with all current applicants.
5. The Marty Royce Bader Selection Committee selects the recipients.
6. Applications must conform to space limitations. The Committee will not consider additional information. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
7. Completed application forms, including official transcripts from all universities attended (*excluding Queen's University transcripts*), and three letters of reference must be received by the Associate University Registrar (Student Awards), Queen's University, by **February 15, 2024**. Submission is acceptable by mail or e-mail. *Additional items beyond what is requested in this application will not be accepted by, nor submitted to, the selection committee for review. Please adhere to the space/word limitations of this application.*

The application must be completed in full and should be typed or printed in black ink. Feel free to create a facsimile of this application on your own computer, but please ensure that all questions are included and answered in the same order.
