

**Report to Senate
November 2007 Enrolment Report
Executive Summary**

Attached are several tables reporting Queen's University enrolment data as of November 1, 2007. The summary tables include current and historical data reported according to full-time and part-time status, program and year of study, gender, age, and international visa students. The annual report on enrolment, consistent with the enrolment plan, is based on the actual number of students, or head count, and does not report on FTEs or BIUs which comprise the detailed government count report filed each November with the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities.

The report and supporting tables highlight that actual enrolment meets enrolment targets and projections in almost all programs. The Enrolment Plan approved by Senate in March 2007 supported the strategic objective to decrease undergraduate full-time enrolment while increasing enrolment in graduate programs, projecting limited overall growth in the total complement of students. At November 1, 2007, total full-time enrolment is 25 students more than 2006, representing a net decrease in undergraduate enrolment of approximately 198 students with increases in graduate enrolment in the School of Graduate Studies and Research (+153) and the School of Business (+70).

In summary, the **total full-time enrolment of 16,572** is relative to a planned range of 16,604 – 16,632 with higher than planned growth in graduate programs in the School of Business accounting for the higher than projected total. The overall enrolment at the University on November 1, 2007, including all part-time, Theological College and Post-Graduate Medical students, was **20,518**, compared to a total of 20,352 in 2006.

Highlights:

- More than 26,300 applications were received for 3,327 full-time spaces available in direct-entry undergraduate programs and 3,298 first year students are enrolled, including 131 at the International Study Centre. Comparable figures for 2006 were 23,500 applications for 3,217 spaces with 3,120 enrolled as at November 1.
- The overall entering average of the Class of 2011 was 87.4%. Approximately one-third of the entering class presented admission averages of 90% or greater, with 7% presenting averages of at least 95%.
- First year enrolment targets for most undergraduate programs were achieved or exceeded, with minor short-falls in Science and Computing Science, as well as in the number of ISC students from our CUSAP partner universities. Upper year enrolment at the ISC in the fall term continues to be a challenge, with only 21 students registered, less than the modest target of 40. The challenge for the fall term results in the requirement of more first-year students to meet capacity and thereby presents a limiting factor on upper year potential enrolment for winter term which typically has much higher demand.
- Total direct-entry undergraduate enrolment of 11,729 falls 74 full-time students short of planned projections or 99% accuracy, demonstrating the efficacy of the enrolment model for forecasting retention and returning student enrolment as well as the accuracy of predicting acceptance rates (@ 98% of target).
- Enrolment in professional programs [Law, Medicine and Education] is on target (1551 actual compared to the plan of 1558), somewhat over the actual November 1 2006 enrolment of 1534.
- Enrolment in the School of Graduate Studies and Research meets the projection for the total number of Doctoral students but falls somewhat short of planned growth in Masters' programs (96% of planned enrolment). Overall, enrolment in SGSR programs increased by more than 150 students, including an increase of more than 100 international students, more than 60 in year one. A total of 2,569 students are registered full-time in the School of Graduate Studies and Research.
- Graduate enrolment also grew in the School of Business, with two classes of consecutive Cornell-Queen's MBA students registered on November 1, combined with increases in other MBA program streams and the introduction of the Master of Management program in Global Management. Full-time graduate enrolment in Business of more than 550 is included in Queen's overall full-time graduate enrolment of almost 3,130 students. Part-time graduate enrolment grew very slightly to 368 (347 in 2006).
- Enrolment of international students studying at Queen's on a student visa grew again, with a total of 1,223 registered full-time and part-time in undergraduate and graduate programs compared to a total of 1,097 in 2006. International students make up 4.4% of the undergraduate full-time enrolment (4.0% in 2005; 4.3% in 2006), and 17.0% of the graduate full-time enrolment (14.0% in 2005; 14.8% in 2006). Students at Queen's on international student visas represent a wide diversity of backgrounds, originating from 95 discrete countries around the world

(graduate students from 72 different countries and undergraduates from 76). It should be noted, that reported visa student enrolment is a conservative representation and under-estimates the international diversity on campus. For example, figures exclude all landed and permanent resident Canadians, as well as domestic students admitted who were resident of countries outside of Canada at the time of admission.


- Part-time enrolment remains consistent with 2006, with a small increase in continuing education enrolment in the Faculty of Education.
- The overall percentage of women at Queen's continues to remain consistent at approximately 57%. Women represent almost 65% of enrolment in Arts and Science, 95% in Nursing and 76% in Education, while there are more men in the Engineering (77.5%) and Computing Science (70.5%). Gender appears to be more at parity in Commerce, Medicine and Law programs. Males make up 54% of full-time students in the School of Graduate Studies and Research (55.7% in 2006) and only 45.9% of students registered part-time (46.6% in 2006).

This summary report provides a snapshot of enrolment that may be considered representative of the University's overall enrolment profile. The University continues to meet enrolment plans and expectations approved by the Senate. Continued attention will have to be focused on graduate student expansion plans and projections to meet Queen's overall enrolment goals and objectives as well as positioning the University to take advantage of the opportunities available from the Provincial Government's goal to increase domestic eligible graduate student enrolment over the next several years.
