The School of Religion at Queen's University invites applications from suitably qualified candidates interested in teaching an undergraduate course in **Yoga in India and the West (RELS 322/822)**. This is an on-campus, upper-level lecture course with an expected enrolment of ~95 students. Candidates should have a Ph. D, and teaching experience at the University level in Religious Studies. This is a fall term appointment for the period September 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026, with classes in session from September 8, 2026, to December 8, 2026.

The University invites applications from all qualified individuals. Queen's is strongly committed to employment equity, diversity and inclusion in the workplace and encourages applications from Black, racialized/visible minority and Indigenous people, women, persons with disabilities, and 2SLGBTQ+ persons. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, in accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority.
