**2) New Business**

**2.1 Response: 18 & 20 Barrie St.**

D. Langham shared that Environmental Health and Safety continues to update guidelines to match the Reopening of Ontario Act. Part of the document that incorporates meetings and events has been sent to Committees to review for comments and feedback. This document outlines scenarios of events where there is no physical distancing and food at an event.


A committee meeting will be booked for January 2022. The 2022 schedule will be discussed, and a decision made whether we will continue to have monthly meetings or they will be less frequent.
