UNDER THE MICROSCOPE CREATE MICROSCOPE INSPIRED SALT ART

- Take a piece of watercolour paper. Wet your paintbrush in the water and dip it into the water colour paint.
- Paint onto your piece of paper.
- Sprinkle a small amount of salt over the wet paint. Do this before the paint dries.
- Repeat steps 2 and 3 to add more colours and texture.
- Experiment! What happens when you add the salt first? What happens when you use lots of salt? How does the type of salt affect the outcome?

What is happening?

Salt absorbs water. When salt is placed on the watercolour paint, it absorbs the nearby water, similar to a sponge. When salt sucks water to itself, this is called *osmosis*.

- Watercolour Paint

- Salt
