

Photovoice Exhibit

Photovoice is a fun activity that allows us to express our feelings and experiences through photos. In this kid-friendly photovoice exhibit, you'll get to share what is important to you by creating your own exhibit at home. Here's how to do it:

Materials Needed:

- Markers, coloured pencils, or crayons
- Paper
- Cardboard
- Optional: decorations like stickers, glitter, or any other craft supplies you like



CHOOSE A THEME

Decide what you want your photovoice to be about. It could be your family, pets, nature, or anything else you like drawing pictures of!



START DRAWING!

Grab your paper and pencils and draw 3 different photos about why the theme is important to you!



ARRANGE YOUR PICTURES

Lay out your pictures on the cardboard and move them around until they tell a story or show something special. Glue them down & decorate!



ADD WORDS

Use your markers to write a story for each drawing – share what is happening and why it is important to you. This helps people understand what is happening in your pictures.



SHARE YOUR PHOTOVOICE!

Show off your photovoice to your family and friends. Take a moment to think about what you enjoyed most about making your photovoice.
