Highlights

Senate's September 26 meeting included a Committee of the Whole discussion regarding the proposed elimination of the Queen's Graduate Awards, and the matter was subsequently referred to four Senate committees for review and response. Senate received a report from SCADP, which had been asked to consider the continued inclusion of "O Canada" in the Convocation program. Senators were informed that the Committee is not recommending any changes at this time.

At the October 24 meeting, the members engaged in a Committee of the Whole session regarding the new Strategic Research Plan. Members offered feedback to the Vice-Principal, Research, and the Plan will return to Senate in November for final approval.

On the recommendation of standing committees, the Senate approved:

- Establishment of the Peter Taylor Professorship in Mathematics and Statistics;
- A <u>Department Name Change: From Department of English Language and Literature to Department of English Literature and Creative Writing.</u>

Principal/Provost/Vice-Principal Research Remarks

In his report, the Principal commended the work of those involved in Orientation and movein, noting that all events ran smoothly. He informed Senate of the ongoing efforts to finalize Queen's new Strategic Mandate Agreement, SMA4 (2025-2030), with the provincial government.

The Provost noted that undergraduate enrolment targets are on track, as well as the university's international target.
