

## Poster Requirements:-

- We recommend a standard poster size of 36" x 48". The P&CC at Queen`s University, for example, uses this standard. The absolute maximum would be 48" x 48".
- Be clearly organized. The poster should tell a narrative and flow logically from one idea to the next.
- The poster should include the Queen`s logo plus other institutional logos (For trainees from Ottawa U or U of Manitoba).
- Mention the SERA program and that it is funded by NSERC (you should include the NSERC logo as well).
- Include all collaborators (including yourself) and their institutional affiliations.
- Use large text (text should be at least 18-24 pt; headings 30-60 pt; title >72pt). You want to make sure that the print is visible even for those who aren't right in front of the poster.
- Choose fonts that are easy to read (such as Times New Roman and Arial)
- Choose colors carefully and pay attention to contrast. Generally, dark print on light background is best.
- Avoid low-resolution images; make sure all graphics are high-resolution (at least 300ppi) and easily visible
