Queen's University is committed to providing non-judgmental sexual violence support and response. The [Sexual Violence Prevention and Response](#) website offers information on a range of services available both on and off campus for those who want help. It also contains advice on how to provide help for people responding to a disclosure of assault.

Sexual Violence means any sexual act or act targeting a person's sexuality, gender identity or gender expression, whether the act is physical or psychological in nature, that is committed, threatened or attempted against a person without the person's consent, and includes sexual assault, sexual harassment, stalking, indecent exposure, voyeurism, and sexual exploitation.
