

How to Stay Safe on Campus

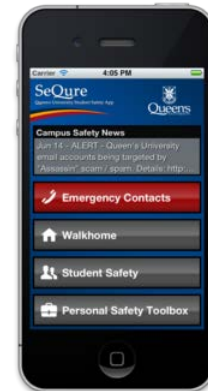


Blue Lights & Emergency Phones

Outdoor Emergency Phones are easily identified on campus by their blue lights and yellow boxes with a large red button. They are located on frequently traveled routes to create better access to emergency services along those areas.

SeQure – Queen’s Student Safety App

SeQure is a mobile safety app for Queen's students. It provides quick access to campus security resources, including the campus security emergency line, and student government services such as AMS Walkhome. The app currently works on iPhone, iPad, Android, and Blackberry devices and is available for download from the iTunes App Store, Google Play, or Blackberry App World.



AMS Walkhome

The **Walkhome program** is a safety service for students provided by the Alma Mater Society. Staffed by students who will walk you from one point to another within Walkhome's boundaries, the service is open between dusk and 2 or 3 am. A team of one male and one female will walk with you to your destination. They can be reached by phone at 613-533-9255.



When Walkhome is off duty, you may call Safe Walk for escorted walks from one point on campus to another. They can be reached at 613-533-6080.
