Queen's housing for graduate students:

The university offers two complexes targeted to graduate students, [John Orr Tower](#) and [An Clachan](#). You must apply for these apartments and they fill up quickly, so be sure to consider your options right away! You can find [applications](#) for these apartments online through the Community Housing website.



John Orr Tower

- 16 story building
- 123 one-bedroom units
- Balcony for each unit



An Clachan (gaelic for "small village")

- Series of 19 apartment buildings
- Total of 260 units
- 1, 2, and 3 bedroom units
