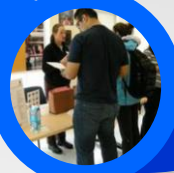

**Fall:** Submit Annual Progress Report for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year; Complete writing of your thesis.  
**Winter:** Prepare for & complete the oral thesis exam.  
**Summer:** Pass the oral exam & complete any required revisions.
