As a result, these awards include an Ontario residency criterion as well as financial need proven through the application to the Ontario Student Assistance Plan (OSAP) each year.</p> <p>To accept the OSOTF award named in the attached letter, you</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>MUST</b> be a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant, <b>AND</b></li> <li>2. <b>MUST</b> meet the following Ontario residency definition:</li> </ol> <p><b>Ontario Residency Definition for OSOTF II and OTSS Awards</b></p> <p>Queen's University will apply the following definition of Ontario resident for the purposes of OSOTF II and OTSS awards: An Ontario resident is deemed to be a student who is a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada who has most recently lived in the Province of Ontario for a period of at least 12 consecutive months, excluding time spent as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution. All reasonable effort will be exercised to determine the residency of potential recipients to ensure conformation with the Ontario residency restriction from the OSOTF II and OTSS guidelines. This will entail ensuring that both the address on admission and the undergraduate institution of the student were in Ontario. Where these criteria do not apply, the student may be eligible if he/she can prove residency in Ontario twelve months prior to registration at the undergraduate university.</p>
