**Listening test: 20 (out of 30), for a TOEFL iBT minimum TOTAL SCORE: 88 (out of 120). Applicants must have the minimum score in each test, as well as the minimum overall score.

**The Department of English, and the Graduate programs in the Faculty of Law, Medical Sciences and the School of Policy Studies, have higher minimum TOEFL iBT requirements. See their websites for details.
