

BUILD RESEARCH PARTNERSHIPS

Mitacs Accelerate supports collaborative research between faculty, a non-academic partner, and a graduate student or postdoctoral research intern. You get flexible funding for new collaborations, experiential training for your researchers, and a grant starting at \$15,000.

Who is eligible?

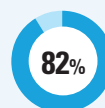
- > Professors who are eligible to hold Tri-Council funding
- > All academic disciplines and sectors
- > Master's and PhD students and postdoctoral fellows (Canadians, permanent residents, or international students)
- > Companies and approved not-for-profit organizations operating in Canada

Research funding that's flexible and fast

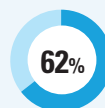
- > Applications accepted anytime
- > 6–8 week evaluation
- > Projects can be as long as you need (minimum of 4 months)
- > Projects can include multiple interns, universities, and partner organizations
- > Mitacs matches partner contributions with federal and provincial funding to support projects of any size

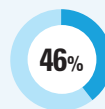
